

Hi, my name is Lea! Today I'm going to tell you all about how my parents and I fish safely.

Our boat is 30 feet long, which is about the length of a school bus!


Before I'm allowed on, I have to put on a PFD (Personal Flotation Device) or life jacket.



Trace the Dotted Line to Help Lea Put on her Life Jacket! When we know we're going out on our boat, we leave a sail plan at home with someone we trust.

A sail plan is a form with information on it, like the colour of your boat, the length of your boat, where you are going, and what time you expect to be home.

These details help Search & Rescue teams know what to look for if anything happens!

Mom and dad's boat is called Lea's Dream, and it's named after me!

On board we have many pieces of safety equipment.




















Defibrillator


